

There were dramas of various tastes ranging from dance dramas to some with a social message or a hilarious theme. Some local popular drama troops were also invited.




Notice for Rabindra Jayanti



Notice for Basantotsab

The spring festival 'Basantotsab' was celebrated at Rabindra Mahavidyalaya on 17th of March 2022. A spring festival of such dimension involving all departments was something the college witnessed for the first time. The small patch of woods at the boundary of the college was chosen as the venue of the open-air programme. The

dais amidst the trees, lined by green carpet was created with the shade of green matching the young green leaves sprouting in spring. Students decorated the dais with garlands of orange marigolds and made a colourful hoarding of 'Basantotsab' with the name of the college and '1428' the Bengali year. Chairs were laid on the lush green grass under the cool shade of the trees. Soon the students began to arrive. The panorama of hundreds of girls in yellow sari, garlands in their hair and boys in yellow kurta was breathtaking. Teachers too matched them in wearing different hues of yellow. All were eager to join the procession, a signature event for Basantotsab in Bengal, as propagated by Tagore in Viswabharati. At around noon the procession started from the west corner of the college near the Botany department. Students went dancing and singing, sprinkling flowers and abir (powdered colour) in the air. The famous song "Ore Grihobashi, Khol Dar Khol" where Tagore invokes people to come out of their houses and be part of the beautiful nature of spring was chosen as the theme song. The teachers also joined the students in the rally, which ended at the dais. Next the main programme commenced. Students put up brilliant performances of several songs, recitation and dances based on works by several Bengali poets and Tagore. The audience was mesmerized by the apt performances of the participants. Interestingly the teachers also took part by giving a chorus performance of two songs by Tagore. The theme throughout, not to mention was 'Spring'. The shady trees, the grassy playground, the college building in the background, the touchy poetry and the lilting melody of the songs indeed added up to an ethereal experience that Rabindra Mahavidyalaya would always look forward to.


KHO-KHO CHAMPIONSHIP WOMEN- 15.02.2023




