Some students also expressed their gratitude towards this celebration by giving short speeches. Students performed cultural activities like dance, songs, recite etc. on this special occasion.

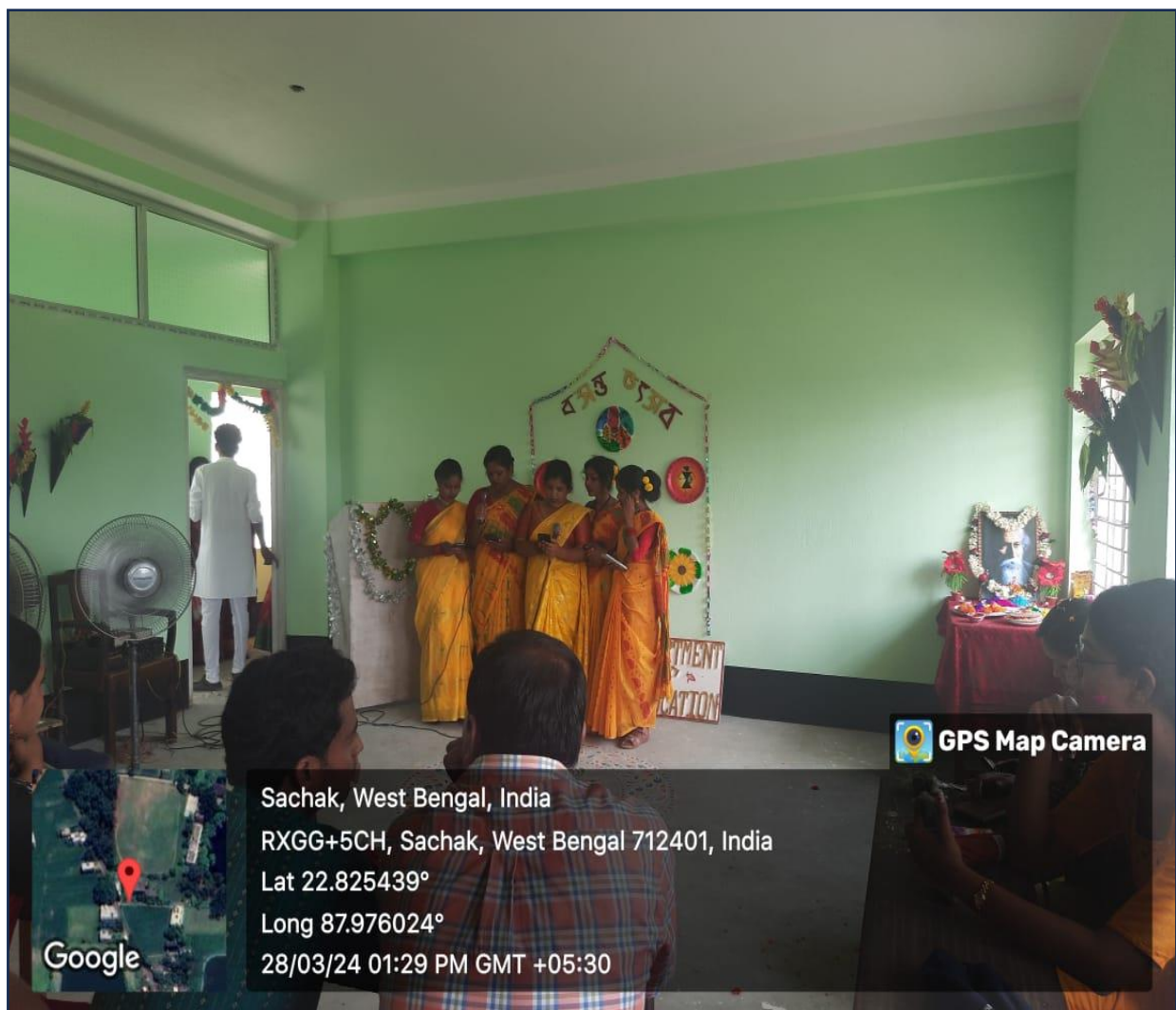
All the teachers enjoyed and appreciated the programme and the event came to an end around 3.00 p.m.

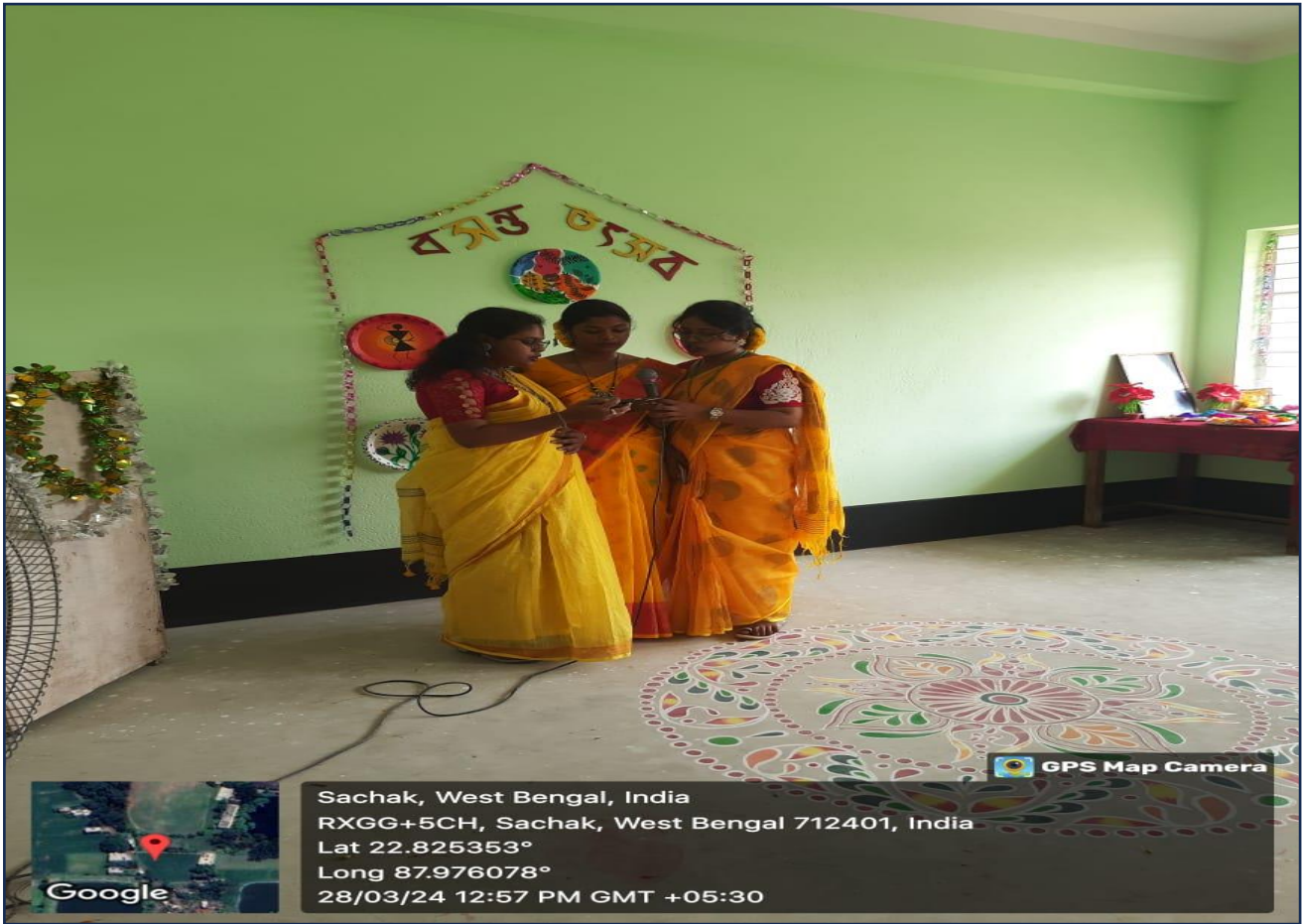








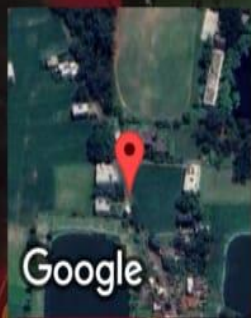








 GPS Map Camera


