THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (the MCU) is entered on O3.05.2623 (Wednesday) BETWEEN RABINDRA MAHAVIDYALAYA, Champadanga AND PURBASHA ECO HEIPHIE SOCIETY, Sundarban.

RABINDRA MARAVI DYALAYA

From very early on, Champadanga had a steady economy based on the opulent vegetation of the area. But sadly for the local people, they missed out on higher educational opportunities. Fortunately, it was in 1971 and on the memorable birth-centenary of Rabindranath Tagore that a group of social workers, businessmen and educationists of the locality decided to setup a Degree College with a dream of bringing

higher education to the doors of the locals. For this purpose, they formed a preparatory Committee with the following members. Frasad Chandra Mandal (President), Nityananda Adhikari (Secretary), Prof. marendraneth idak(Secretary), Nandalal Dutta, Panchkari Fal, Frankrishna Fondal, Baidyanath Dutta, Amiya Aumar Cupta, jit Aumar Maji, Sk. Answar Ali Middya, Santimohan Roy, Kansingha Fal, Rusan Maitra, Lalitmohan mazra, Sk. B.J. Naskar, Sk. Soni wiedya and hashinath Mondal.

From them on, it took a few years to select a suitable place for

eracting the college building. At that time, Late metal Charan tazra and his wife Late Phelubala mazta jointly donated a princely win of he. 20,000/- along with a plot of 307 Sataks of land by thst side of the Cld Benaras Road, about 1.5 km. away from Champaangs bus stop. A great number of local persons from cliferent strate of society also came forward with their invaluable denation and timely help. A two-storied building on the northern side of the big pond of the donated area was built under the supervision of the Preparatory Committee. Finally, our college thebinger Mahavidys. ya! affiliated to the University of Burdwan, Officially started its journey on and from OSth November 1971. We heartily remember all those founder fathers, social workers, educationalists, businessmen, and a host of well-intended persons for their honest contributions in w setting up this College and fulfilling a their vision of making an enlightened, informed and confident local community a reality.

Initially, only eight students were admitted to the PrepUniversity course and twenty-five students to the B.Com Pass course. The official status of the institution was that of an undertaking college and the teacher and the non - teaching staff did

staff did not get their salary from the Government. Only in lieu of a 'pocket allowance', they were shouldering the great task of running of the new born college with utmost sincerity. Then it was in the academic session of 1972-73 that the B.A. course in the Pre-University and Degree level started. In the decade of the '80s atther of the preceding century, a steady inflow of funds in the form of various monetary aids granted to this institution either by the State Government or by the University Grants Commission or by similar such agencies made it possible for fast-paced development of the different wings of the institution. Only aftered four agencies made its possible.

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college now has a pretty long list of assets to its credit,

middle with thickly foliaged shady trees along with its
embankment truly evoke the bygone charms of a pastoral setting.

The dream has become a reality, It has now a student population of nearly three thousand and five hundred and they are offered quite a remarkable list of 18 Honours and 15 General subjects to choose from. They are also provided with other academic facilities like the Learning Resource Centre, Computerized Library Facility, Career Counselling Cell, Smart Digital Classroom etc. for their benfit. As a result, in the arena of higher education of the district, the students of Rabindra

Mahavidyalaya, mostly hailing from the local peasant community, are able to make glorious marks at various levels of University Examinations and other competitive tests and put their x Alma Mater very high on the scale of excellence. This is also borne out by the fact of achieving the grade of 'B4+as part of the re-accreditation recently undergone by the institution and carried out by the national academic benchmarker, Mational Assessment and Accreditation Council (MAAC).

The activities under this MoUshall be coordinated, monitored and recorded by the Natures's Club and NSS Units of the College and under the aegis of the Internal quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Rabindra Mahavidyalaya, Champadanga and Purbasha Eco Helpline Society, Sundarban.

The visitors will be bound bym the rules and regulations as well as the code of conduct of the host institution.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS :

It is mutually understood and agreed upon by the two Institutes viz. Rabindra Mahavidyalaya, Champdanaga and Purbasha Eco Helpline society, Sundarban that:

- Rabindra Mahavidyalaya and Purbasha Eco Helpline Society, Sundarban may collaborate in various environment related activities and may seek funding from Government and private funding agencies of National and International repute.

 and may jointly guide students at various levels/environmental
 protection activities.

Rabindra Mahavidyalaya and Purbasha Sco Helpline Society, Suhdarban may mutually conduct professional course/training programmes/workshops/seminars/conferences/field study for which certificates will be jointly issued by Rabindra Mahavidyalaya and Purbasha Eco Helpline Society, Sundarban to all candidates after successful completion of the same.
- 4. Incase of any dispute resulting from or related to this NoU, the parties agree to resolve such dispute amicably. This NoU shall be governed and constructed according to the laws of the country for each participating party. Any dispute will be jointly resolved by involving the Principal of Rabindra Mahavidyalaya and the Secretary of Purbasha Eco Helpline Society, gundarban in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and

The MoU may be terminated by either party after giving a notice of six months (180 days) provided that this clause will be operative only if either party at violates the terms of MoU or if the parties feel that no useful purpose would be served by further continuing it either due to change in circumstances or any change in the constitution or structure of the two parties entering into this MoU.
